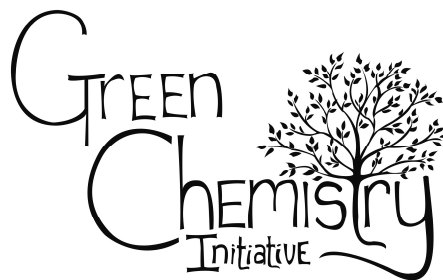


Green Chemistry Applied In Industry

Travel Scholarship Application



The Green Chemistry Initiative (GCI), in cooperation with our sponsors, is pleased to call for applications for this year's competition of the GCI symposium travel scholarship.

These awards have the purpose of allowing undergraduate students, graduate students, and post-doctoral fellows the chance to attend the third annual event by the GCI – the 2015 Symposium entitled “Green Chemistry Applied in Industry.” The maximum value of each award is \$250, to contribute towards travel and accommodation expenses. A maximum of four (4) travel scholarships will be awarded. No financial contribution from the supervisor is required.

DEADLINE

Applications must be received by **April 20th, 2015, 11:59pm EDT** via e-mail to gcisymposium2015@gmail.com with the subject “Travel Scholarship Application.”

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

Eligible applicants must be an undergraduate student, graduate student, or post-doctoral fellow.

All applications must include the following items:

1. A 250-word proposal written by the applicant which outlines the reasons for attendance in terms of the applicant's own professional development.
2. The CV of the applicant, including all publications and presentations (making the applicant's role in each one clear).
3. Estimated Expense Form (see below).

NOTIFICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP DECISION

Scholarship recipients will be decided by the Symposium Organizing Committee. Applicants will be notified whether or not their application was successful via email by Wednesday, April 22, 2015, 11:59pm EDT.

REGISTRATION FEE

All travel scholarship applicants will receive a coupon code with their email notification of scholarship decision, which will give applicants access to the early-bird registration fee of \$60 CAD. The final deadline for all registrations remains May 1, 2015.

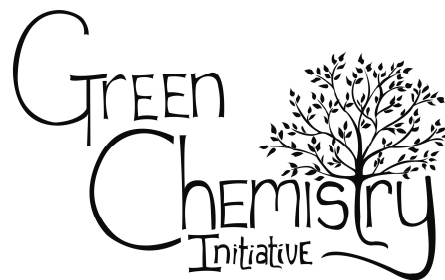
REIMBURSEMENT
